Task One

Equality, Diversity and Rights in Children's Play Learning and Development

Understanding the above terms is essential to professional practice in the Early Years Sector. Professionals such as play therapists, paediatric nurses, teachers and early year's practitioners will all need to have a sound knowledge of each of the terms below and be able to implement them in their practice.

Your task is to research the meaning of each word and explain it in a child care context, giving a real life example if possible.
