
# **History A-Level preparatory summer work**







The course you will be studying over the next two years covers all of the Tudor period 1485-1603. In order to start in September with some understanding of the background to the Tudor Period I want you to carry out come research into the end of the Wars of the Roses and the reign of Henry VII.

Conduct research on the latter part of the War of the Roses and then answer the following questions:

- \* Which House did Henry come from?
- \* Explain two factors that helped Henry to take the throne in 1485.
- \* How did Margaret Beaufort help Henry to take the throne?
- \* How did Elizabeth of York help to strengthen Henry's position?
