Friday 18 January - Terrific Turner

Join our Art Department for an amazing workshop, experiencing different styles of art. We will be looking closely at the work of JMW Turner who is a renowned expert creating masterpieces of shipwrecks and torrential images that take you to another dimension! Studying an artist's work will give the students the opportunity to work with new styles, techniques and materials in preparation for secondary school.

A humanities based day that focuses on the works of historical figures. A well-structured blend of all humanities lessons, including Geography and Philosophy will take you child into the past and enable them to revel in the delights of traditional history.



Friday 15 March – Multi-skills Madness

Come and join the P.E faculty for a day at Walton and develop your team building skills through a variety of fun activities. The day will be based on the core skills that all children will acquire as they move onto secondary school. Outwitting opponents, net/ball skills and elements of fitness will be included. All abilities welcome.



Friday 22 March – Play in a Day

This will be the fourth year we have organised this activity and it is always over-subscribed. Primary pupils will work with our Drama teachers doing team building activities and playing drama games that develop confidence and communication skills. In the past performances have included Matilda, Annie and other well-known productions. Parents will be invited back in at the end of the day to see what their children have done in just one day!



Friday 29 March – Strike a Pose

Pupils will be exploring the environment of our academy and photographs of their own to transform using a digital platform. Our passionate teaching staff will share their own 'tricks of the trade' when introducing how to Photoshop and edit photographs to a high quality standard. Pupils will be expected to bring a mobile phone or digital camera to transfer images.
