Pepinometer

Extra Hot

20 pts

Japanese
Here, you will work out some two-part place names / proper nouns in Japanese.

Swedish
This task involves the Stockholm's (the capital of Sweden) underground map.

Welsh
A tricky logic task, taken from a leaflet from the Welsh library service.

Hot

15 pts

Arabic
In Arabic, each character has a sound BUT you read it from RIGHT to left!

Dutch
Here, you work out the 'past participles' from some regular Dutch verbs.

Maori
The language of the indigenous people of New Zealand. These 'loanwords' are a mix of English and Maori.

Mild

10 pts

It's all Greek to me!
The Greek alphabet, first used 2,800 years ago, descended from Egyptian hieroglyphs via The Phoenician alphabet.

Runes
Old Norse, the language of the Vikings, was written using 'runes' - a specially devised alphabet for carving into stone or wood.

Lemon & Herb

5 pts

Counting in Karelian
A language related to Finnish, spoken in the Russian Republic of Karelia.

Counting from 1 to 99

Yoda-speak
The made-up language from the character of Yoda in the Star Wars movies.
